OVER AND ABOVE AVERAGE (A+/10): *Stellar performance.* Leaves audience “wowed” by presentation. Professional format for every aspect of presentation. Presenters make a strong personal connection with audience throughout. Excellent posture, vernacular, and no sloppiness in personal appearance. Keen attention to detail, including no misspelled words, no mispronunciations, and only accurate information. Equal sharing of presentation duties among group members. A sense that all members are comfortable and competent about topic. Visual and/or tactile components incorporated skillfully. Information presented in an age-appropriate and friendly manner. Group members are receptive to the audience, and answer questions with competence and ease.

ABOVE AVERAGE (A/9-9.5): *Exceeds requirements.* Professional format for nearly every aspect of presentation. Presenters make a personal connection with the audience. Excellent posture, vernacular, and no sloppiness in personal appearance. Attention to detail, including no misspelled words, no mispronunciations, and accurate information. Equal sharing of presentation duties among group members. A sense that all members are comfortable and competent about topic. Visual and/or tactile components incorporated skillfully. Information presented in an age-appropriate and friendly manner. Group members are receptive to the audience, and answer questions with competence and ease.

EXCELLENT (B/8-8.5): *Meets all requirements.* Professional format apparent in nearly all aspects of presentation. Presenters make a personal connection with audience and somewhat engage them. Good posture, vernacular, and no sloppiness in personal appearance. Attention to detail. Only a few misspelled words or mispronunciations, and mostly accurate information. Mostly equal sharing of presentation duties among group members. A sense that most members are comfortable and competent about topic. Visual and/or tactile components utilized appropriately. Information presented in an age-appropriate and friendly manner. Group members are receptive to the audience, and answer most questions with competence and ease.

AVERAGE (C/7-7.5): *Majority of requirements met.* A lack of professionalism and and/or preparation noted. Presenters are unable to make a personal connection with the audience. Poor posture, incorrect vernacular, and sloppiness in personal appearance. Lack of attention to detail. A number of misspelled words or mispronunciations, and some inaccurate information. Not an equal sharing of duties among group members. A sense that some members are not comfortable with, or competent about the topic. Visual and/or tactile components not utilized in the most applicable and effective manner. Information not presented in an age-appropriate manner. Group members are not completely receptive to audience, and answer questions incompletely, or with difficulty.

POOR /UNACCEPTABLE (D/E/6.5 or below): *Very few or no requirements met.* No professionalism and and/or preparation. Presenters do not attempt to make a personal connection with the audience. Poor posture, incorrect vernacular, and overall sloppiness in personal appearance. No attention to detail. An unacceptable amount of misspelled words or mispronunciations, and mostly inaccurate information. Unequal participation and fulfillment of duties by group members. A sense that all members are not comfortable or competent with the topic. Visual and/or tactile components lacking, non-existent, or used inappropriately. Information presented without regard for age, skill level, or competency of audience. Group members non-receptive to audience, and are unable to answer any question.
