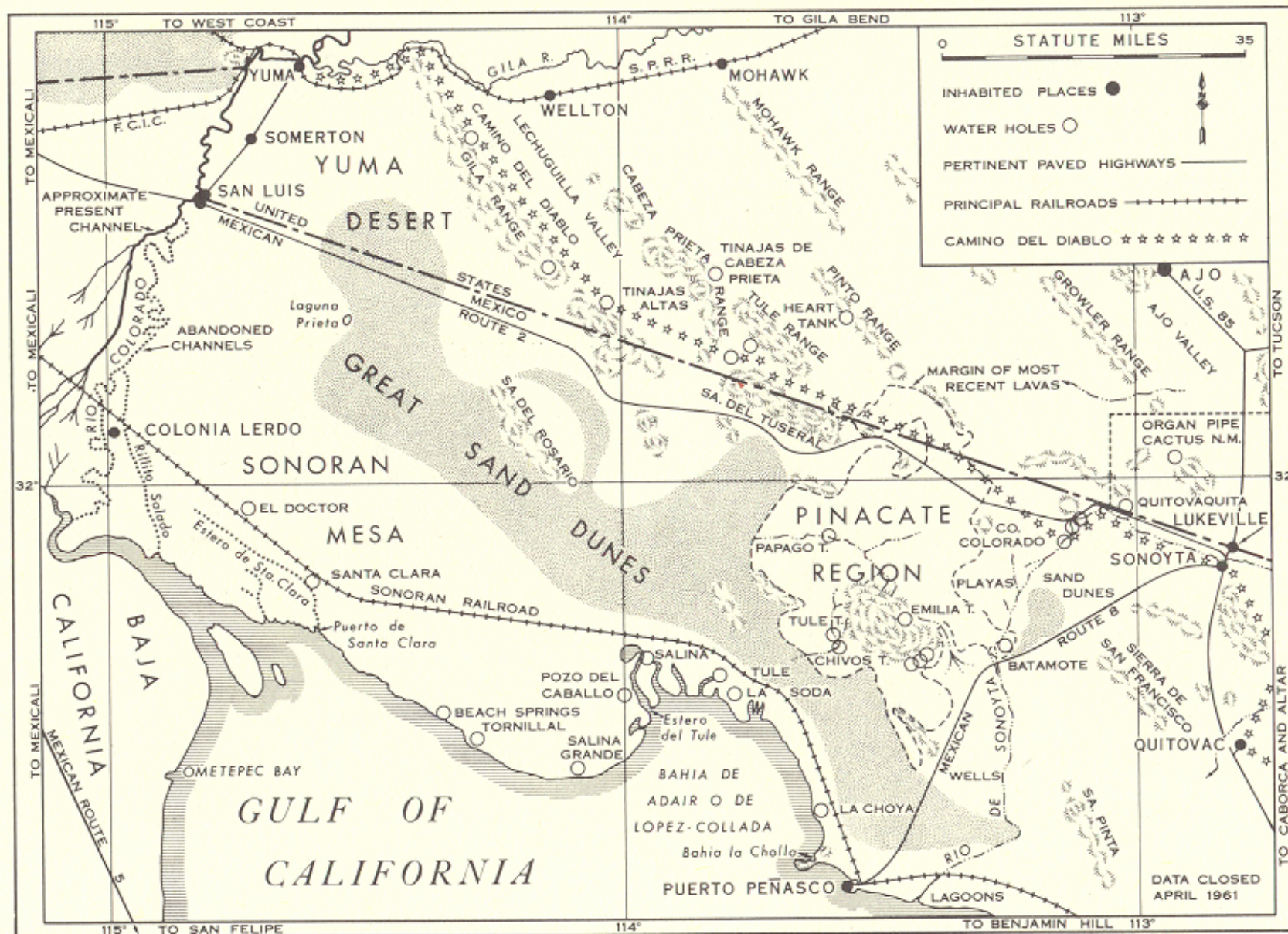


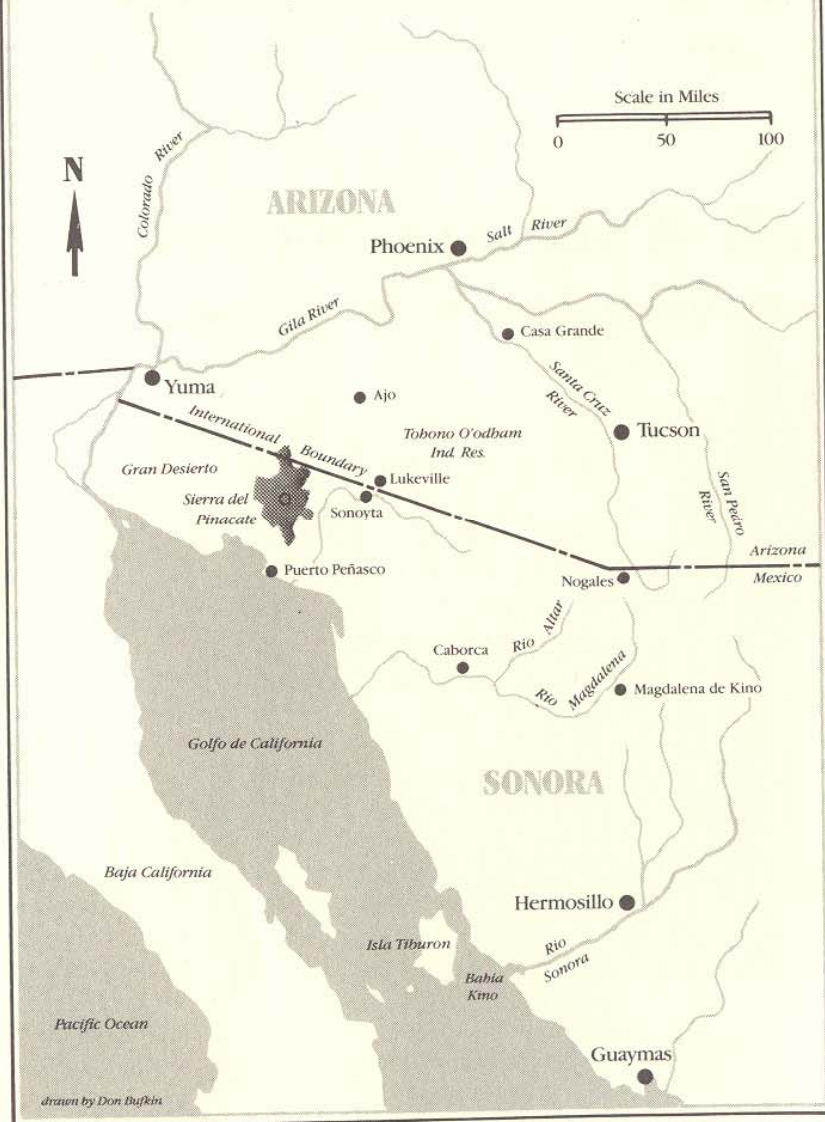
*Summary map of the Pinacate region.*
